

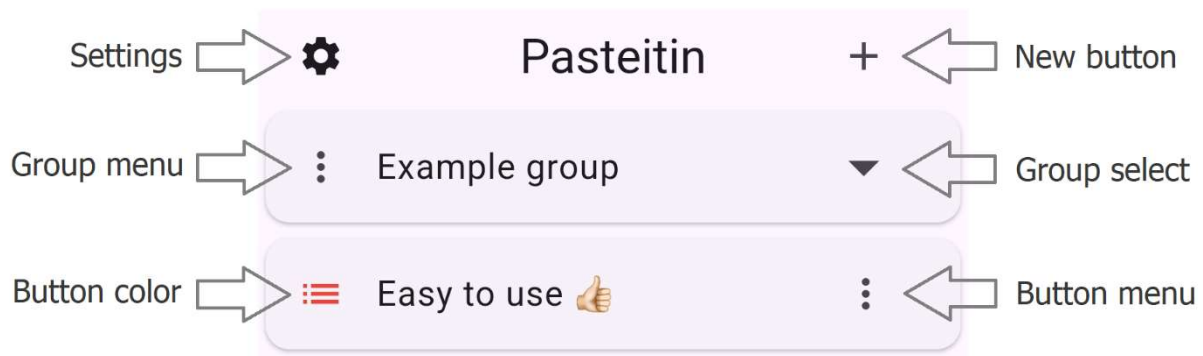

You can create groups of buttons with text that can be pasted into any application. Groups and buttons can be shared to provide a uniform response within your organization.

Main button window



Settings

- Open the settings menu to view this help file and version information.

Group menu

- Open the group menu to create, edit, delete, or share a group.

Button color

- Select a button color or drag to rearrange button order.

New button

- Create a new button and open button editor.

Group select

- Select a group from the list.

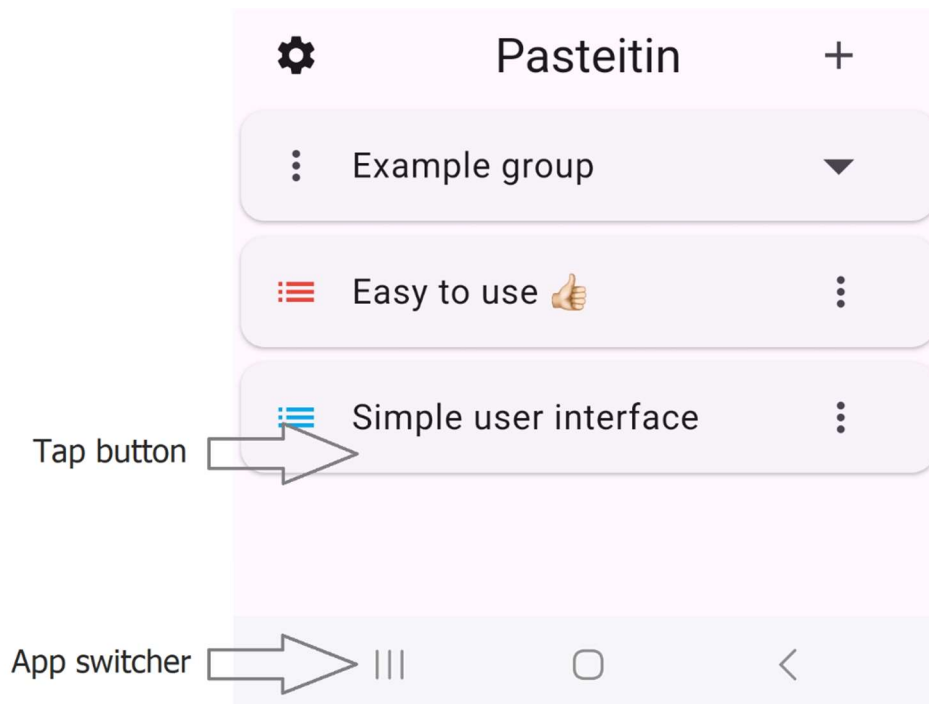
Button menu

- Open the button menu to create, edit, delete, copy, move, or share a button.

You can [swipe left or right on the group name](#) to cycle through available groups. [Long press on the group name](#) to edit the name of the group.

[Tap on a button](#) to copy its contents to the clipboard. [Long press on a button](#) to open the button in the editor. [Swipe right on a button](#) to delete it. [Drag button color icon](#) to move button.

How to use



To use Pasteitin, first [tap on a button](#) to copy its contents to the clipboard.

Then [tap on the App switcher icon](#) to select the app where you want to paste the text.

When the target app is active, [long press where you want to paste the text](#) and select Paste from the pop-up menu.

If you are using Google's Gboard keyboard the copied text will also show in the Suggestions bar if enabled in Gboard settings - clipboard.

You can now [double tap the App switcher icon](#) to switch back to Pasteitin and double tap the App switcher icon again to switch back to the target app.
