User Manual

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Thank you for using Typeitin for macOS from wavget.com.

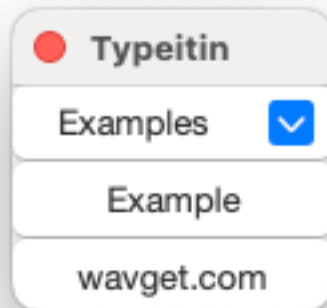
Typeitin macOS was created to increase your productivity. It is not limited to your web browser; it will type for you in any application. Simply click where you want Typeitin to type, and directly after that on the button you want to activate.

You can also assign a shortcut key like Control-Command-S or a shortcut phrase like scp to activate a button.

The simple but powerful user interface is easy to use with a short learning curve; you'll be creating your own buttons in minutes.

Typeitin is free to use for 30 days. You can purchase a license by clicking the Buy license button in the license window.

MAIN BUTTON WINDOW



Title bar

- Right click to show the title bar menu.
- Double click to “roll up” or “unroll” the button window.
- Click the red dismiss button to hide the button window.

Group list

- Right click to show the group menu.

Group select

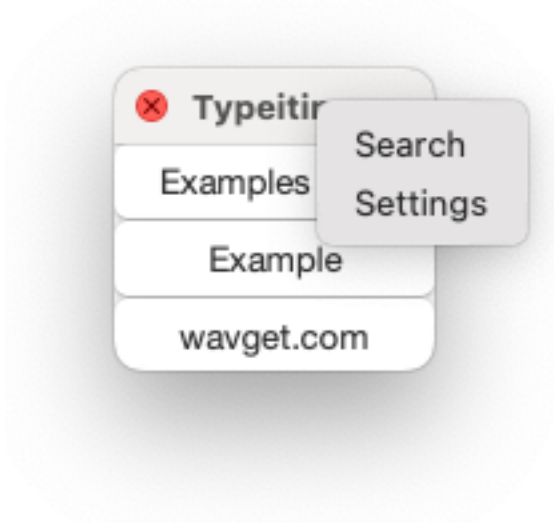
- Click the blue group select button to change groups.
- Right click to cycle through groups. Hold down shift key to cycle in reverse.

Button

- Right click to show button menu.
- Click to activate the button.

To show the button window again after you dismissed it, click on the keyboard icon in the menu bar and select Show window from the menu.

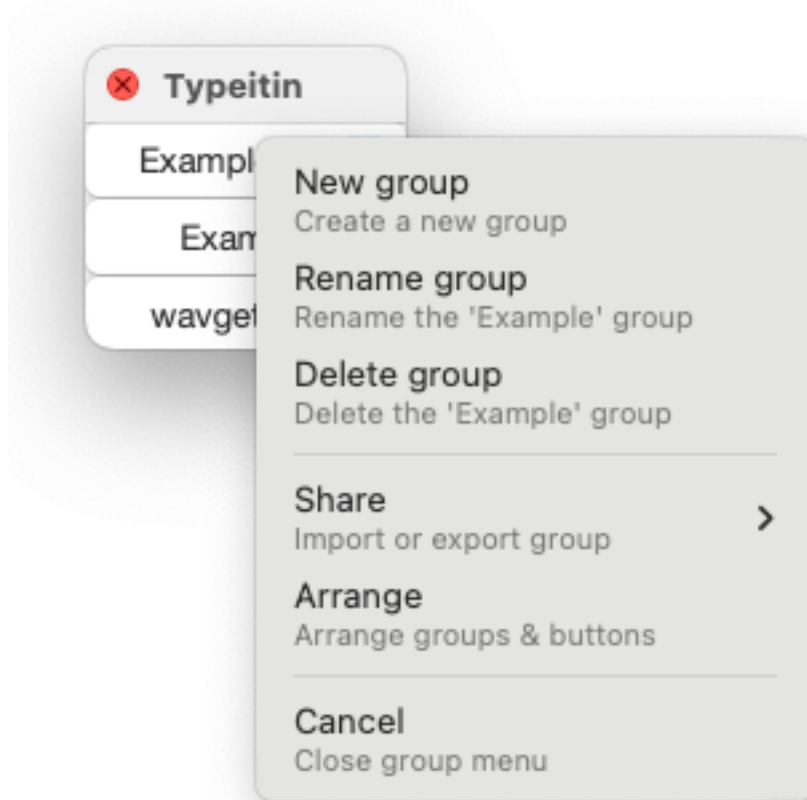
TITLE BAR MENU



Right click (or control – left click) on the title bar text to show the title bar menu.

- **Search**
Open the search window to search for a specific button.
- **Settings**
Open the settings window.

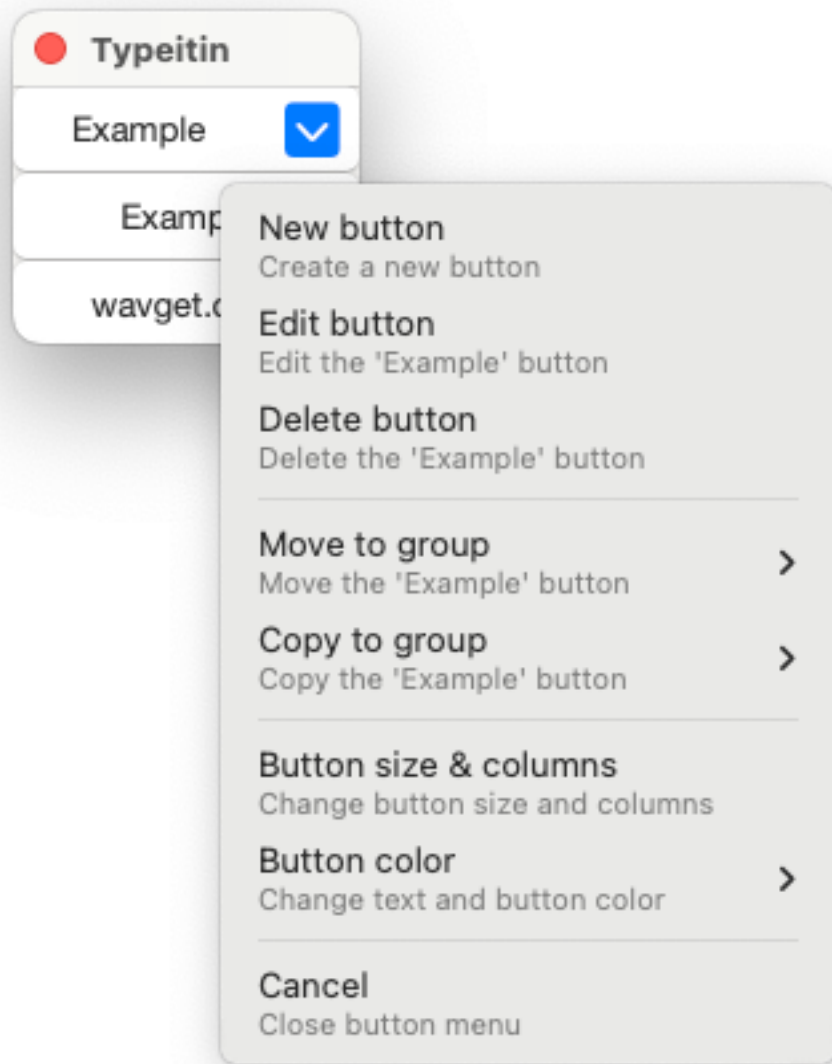
GROUP MENU



Right click (or control – left click) on the group list to show the group menu.

- **New group**
Create a new group.
- **Rename group**
Change the name of the selected group.
- **Delete group**
Delete the selected group and all its buttons.
- **Share**
Export the selected group to a file to share or import a group from a file.
- **Arrange**
Open the arrange window to arrange the order of groups and buttons.
- **Cancel**
Close the group menu.

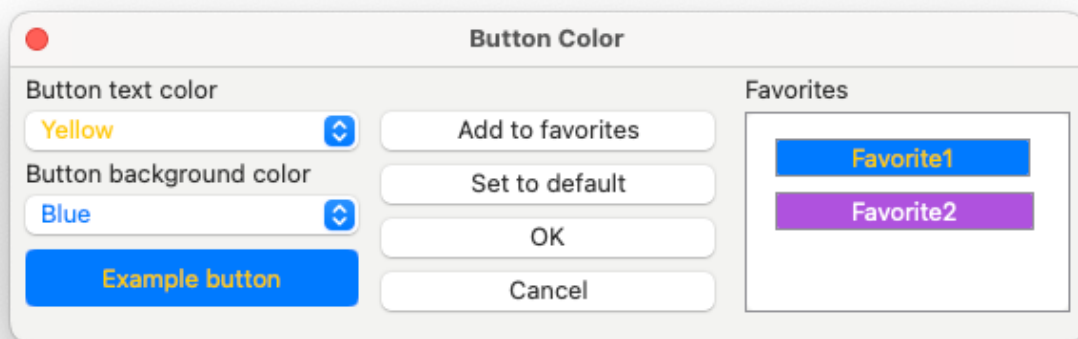
BUTTON MENU



Right click (or control – left click) on a button to show the button menu.

- **New button**
Create a new button and open the edit button window.
- **Edit button**
Open the selected button in the edit button window.
- **Delete button**
Delete the selected button.
- **Move to group**
Move the selected button to another group.
- **Copy to group**
Copy the selected button to another group.
- **Button size & columns**
Open button settings window to adjust button size, font, and number of columns.
- **Button color**
Select a favorite button color combination or open button color editor.
- **Cancel**
Close the button menu.

BUTTON COLOR EDITOR



Right click (or control – left click) on a button and select Color editor from the Button color menu to show the Button color editor.

Select a button text and background color to change the button colors.

Click the Add to favorites button to add the selected color combination to the Favorites list.

Click the Set to default button to reset the button colors to the system default.

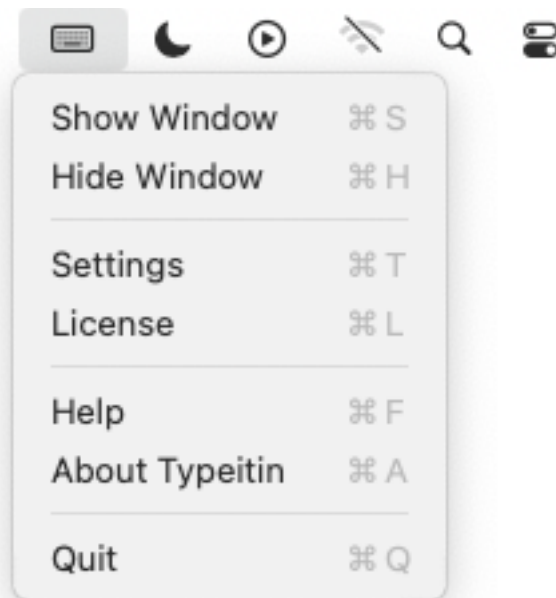
Click the OK button to apply the color combination to the button.

Click the Cancel button to discard any changes to the button colors.

Click on a button in the Favorites list to select that color combination.

Right click (or control – left click) on a button in the Favorites list and select Delete from the menu to remove a favorite color combination from the list.

MENU BAR MENU

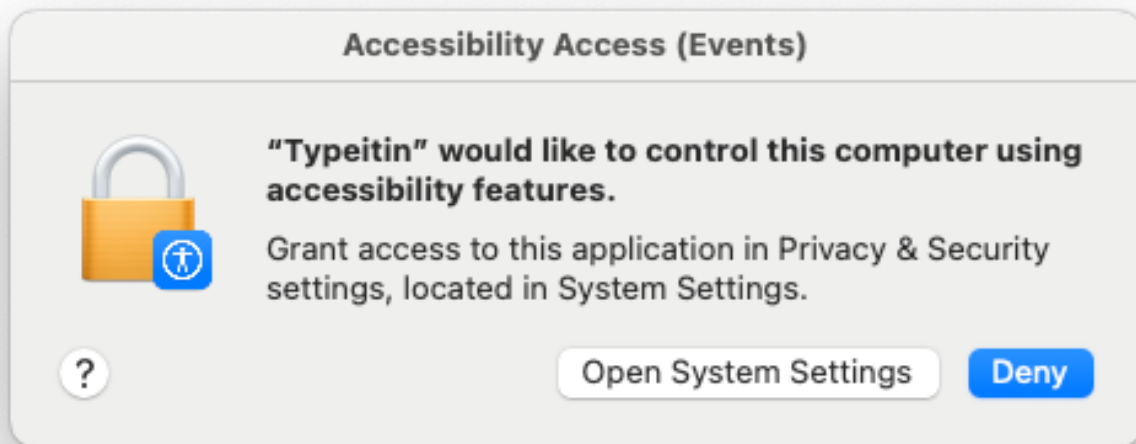


Click on the keyboard icon in the menu bar to show the menu bar menu.

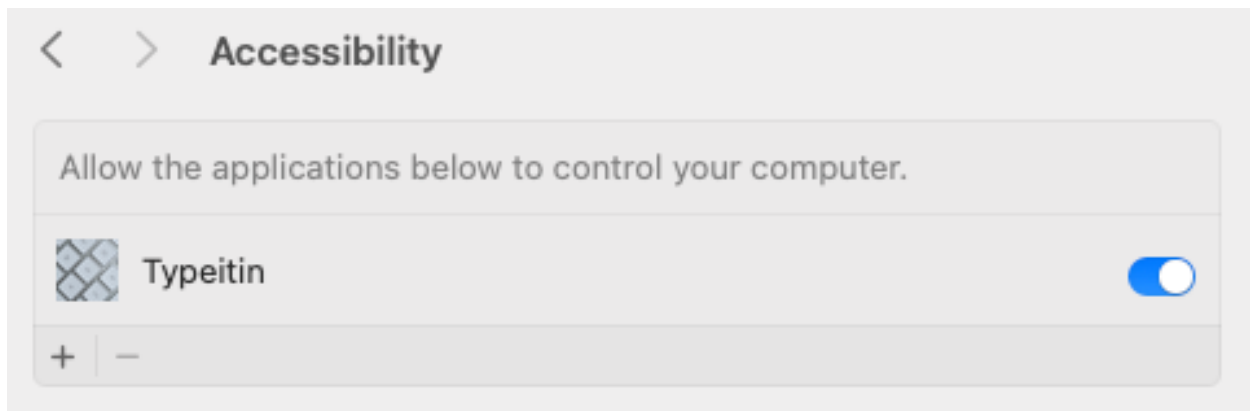
- Show window
Show button window.
- Hide window
Hide button window.
- Settings
Show settings window.
- License
Show license window.
- Help
Show this PDF help file in the default viewer.
- About Typeitin
Show about window with version and license information.
- Quit
Shut down Typeitin and exit.

ACCESSIBILITY ACCESS

Typeitin uses accessibility features to type. The first time you click a button that types text, like the Example button, you will see a notification that Typeitin is requesting access.

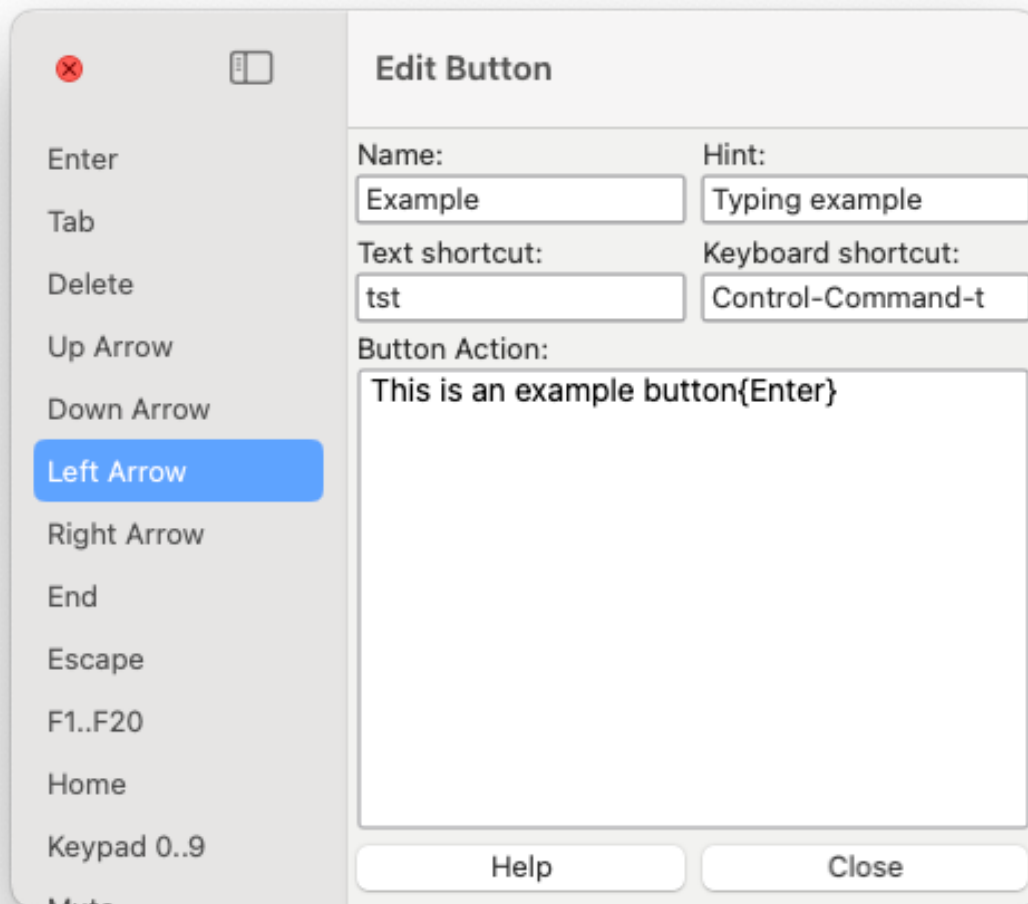


Click Open System Settings and select to allow Typeitin to use the Accessibility features.



Typeitin will not be able to type if this feature is not enabled.

EDIT BUTTON



Right click on a button and select Edit button from the menu to open the edit button window.

The Name is the text that shows on the button. The Hint is the text that will show in a small hint window when you hover the mouse cursor over the button.

You can type directly in the Button action text area to specify what you want the button to type. Double-click on an item in the list on the right to insert a function into the Button action.

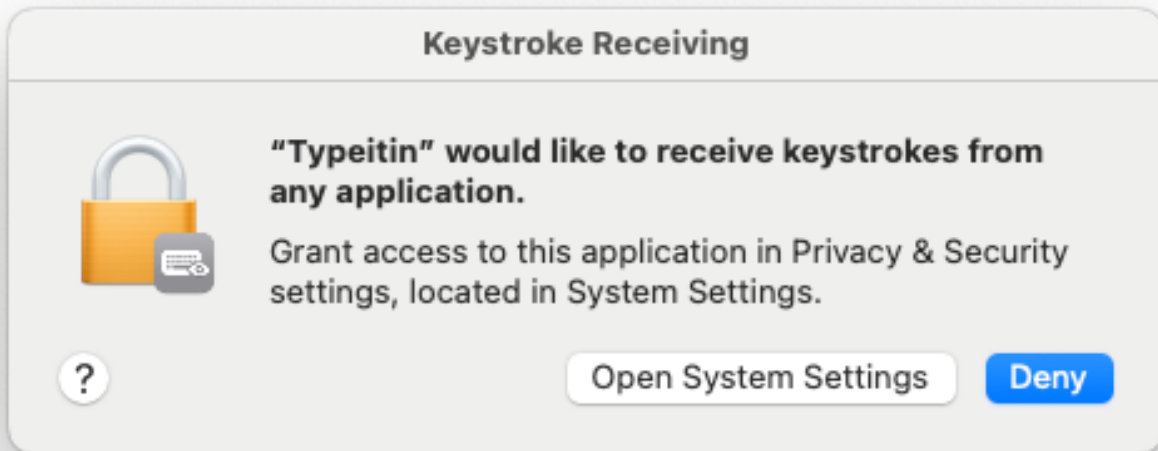
Click the Close button to save any changes or the dismiss button to discard them.

You can assign a Text shortcut to a button to activate it by typing. For example, you can assign *tst* as a shortcut for the Test button. When you type *tst* in any application, a small hint window will appear at the top center of your screen. Press the Control key to activate the button. Typeitin will first erase the *tst* you typed and then type the contents of the button.

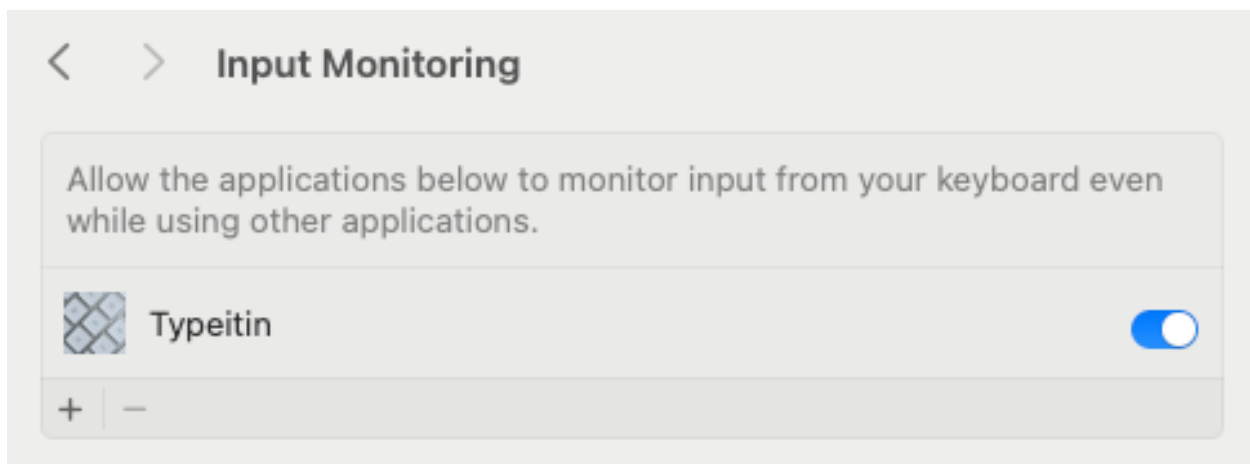
You can also assign a keyboard shortcut to activate a button. For example, you can assign Control-Command-t to activate the button. Click in the keyboard shortcut area and press the Control-Command-t key combination. It will show in the Keyboard shortcut area. Press Delete to erase the shortcut key combination. When you press the Control-Command-t key combination in any application, Typeitin will activate the button.

KEYBOARD INPUT MONITORING

The first time you create a text or keyboard shortcut and save the button information, you will see a notification that Typeitin would like to receive keystrokes from any application.



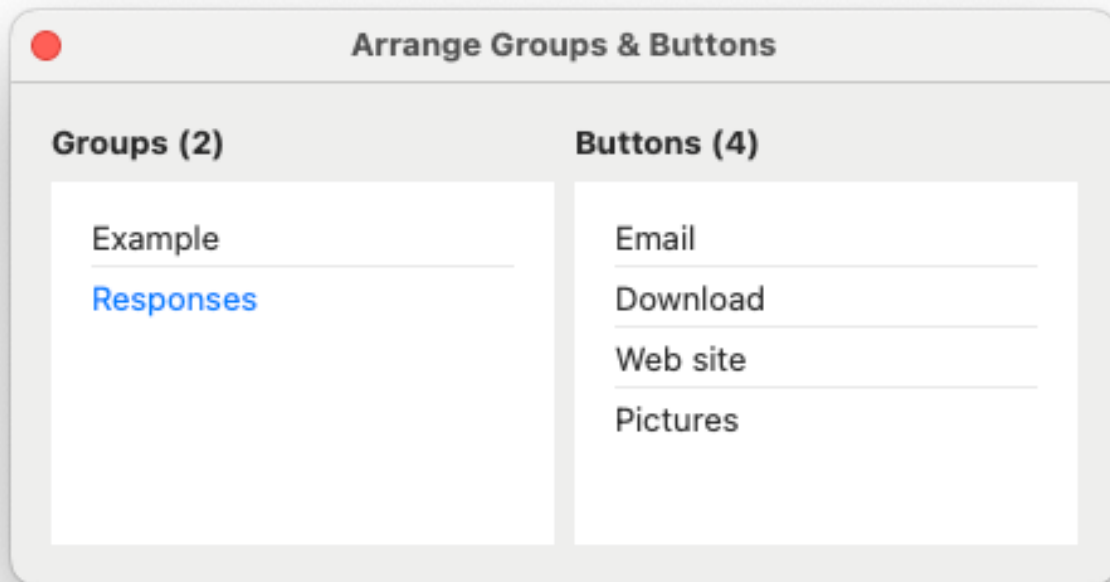
Click Open System Settings and select to allow Typeitin to monitor the keyboard.



The text and keyboard shortcut features will not function without this permission.

Privacy: Typeitin monitors your keyboard activity and tries to match it with a shortcut text or keyboard shortcut you specified for a button. The collected keystrokes are cleared every time you press the escape, space, enter, tab, or arrow keys.

ARRANGE GROUPS AND BUTTONS



Select Arrange from the group menu to show the Arrange window.

You can drag a group name to a different location and drop it to arrange the groups.

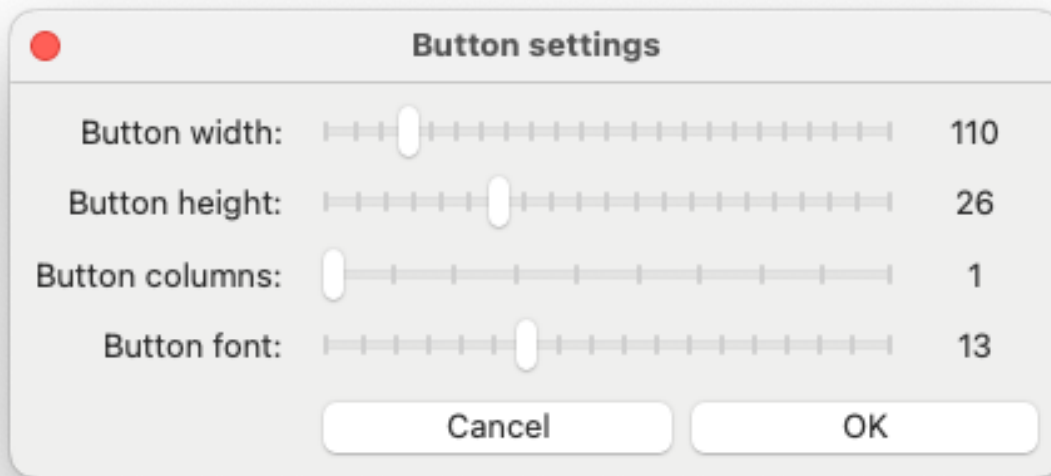
Click on a group name to show the buttons for that group.

Double-click on a group name to switch the button window to that group.

You can drag a button name to a different location and drop it to arrange the buttons.

You can drag a button name to a different group to copy that button to that group.

BUTTON SIZE AND COLUMNS

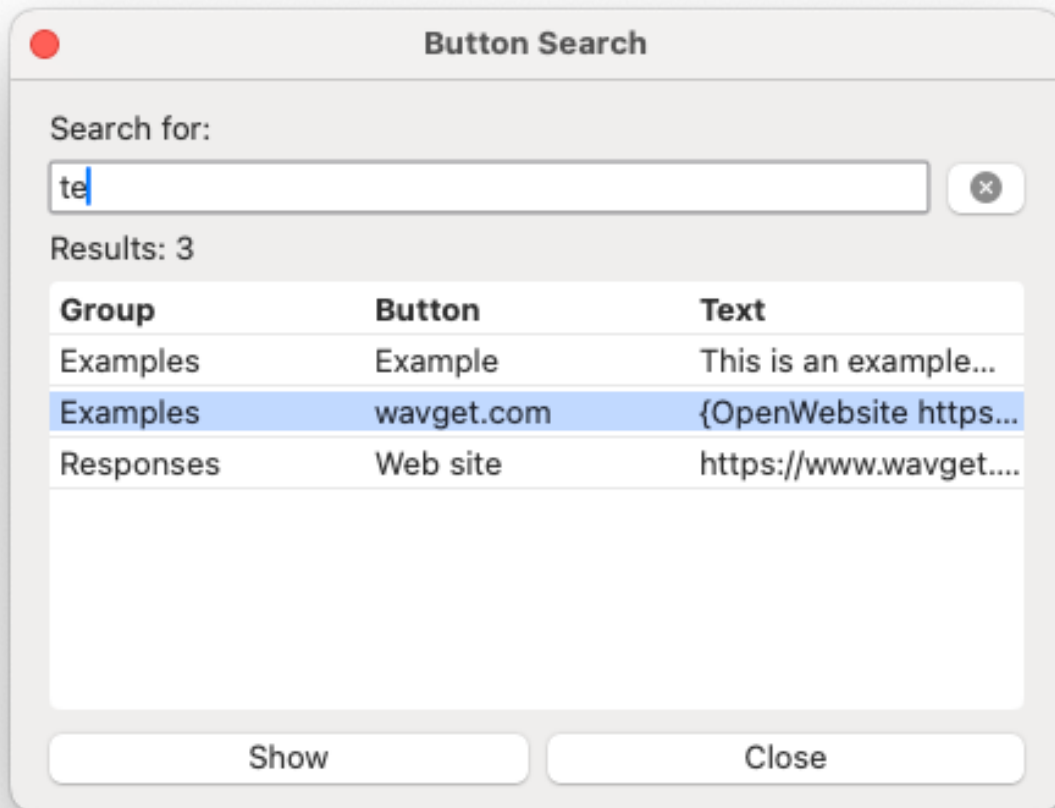


Select button size and columns from the button menu to open the button settings window.

Move the sliders to adjust the button width and height for the selected group.

You can also adjust the number of columns used to display the buttons in the group, and the font size used to display the text on the buttons.

BUTTON SEARCH

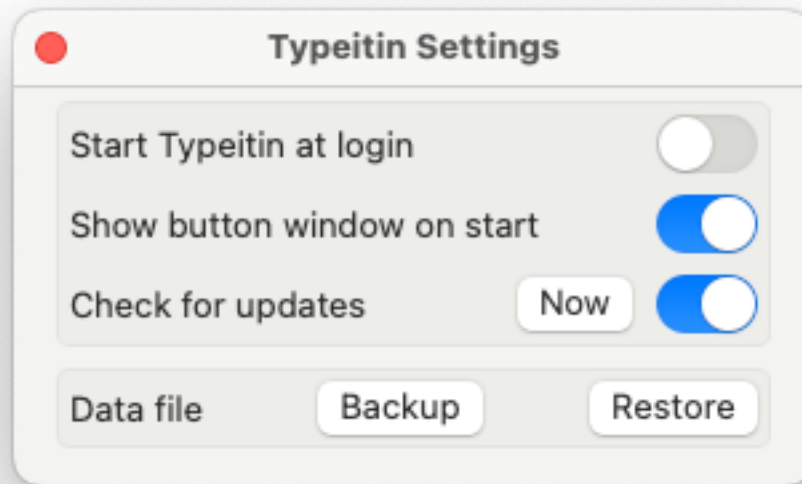


Select search from the title bar menu to open the search window.

Enter the text you want to search for and the results list will update as you type.

Select one of the results and click the Show button. The main button window will switch to the group of the selected result and highlight the button.

SETTINGS



Select settings from the title bar or menu bar menu to open the settings window.

You can select to have Typeitin start automatically when you login and to show the button window when Typeitin first starts.

Typeitin can automatically check for updates once a week. Please allow Alert notifications for Typeitin in System settings. Click the Now button to manually check for an update.

The backup function allows you to save a copy of your Typeitin buttons and settings.

The restore function can be used to restore buttons from a backup or from a Typeitin for Windows datafile.enc file.
